Brasenose College – Oxford Australia Fund Scholarships

1. The Awards

A Scholarship, funded through the generosity of Australians who have studied at Brasenose College, will be available in 2014-2015 for a graduate from Australia to study at Oxford University

The Brasenose College - Oxford Australia Fund Scholarship is open to any discipline and is generally tenable for two years, or, in the case of a D Phil degree, for three years.

2. Eligibility

The scholarships are open to Australian citizens normally resident in Australia, normally under the age of 30 years on 1 January in the year in which the scholarship is to be taken up. They should hold a Bachelor's degree with first class honours, or its equivalent, from a recognised Australian university.

Normally, the scholarship is intended for undergraduate and graduate students, currently studying or working in Australia, to pursue their first international degree.

It is the responsibility of each applicant to ensure that their qualifications meet the requirements of their chosen Oxford University course.

3. Value of the Awards

The scholarships provide up to \$12,000 per annum in the year 2013-14.

Successful candidates may hold other awards with the approval of the Committee. In the case of scholars winning an additional scholarship to Oxford, the Oxford Australia Scholarship Committee will want to know from the scholars its value and may wish to withhold an amount from the Brasenose College - Oxford Australia award.

4. Application Procedure

i. The Oxford University online application requires full documentary evidence of relevant academic performance and reports from three referees. Candidates must also include a statement describing their reasons for applying for this course of study and the Oxford Australia Award and also outline their future career plans and intentions.

ii. Candidates for a Scholarship must apply at the same time as they apply for admission to the University by selecting 'Oxford Australia Scholarship Fund' in the Funding Section of the University's online Graduate Application Form at www.graduate.ox.ac.uk/applyonline.

iii. All graduate applications to Oxford University are automatically considered for a Clarendon Award (<u>www.clarendon.ox.ac.uk</u>).

5. Closing dates and timelines

Oxford University admissions application deadline 2 (check latest deadlines at <u>http://www.ox.ac.uk/admissions/postgraduate_courses/apply/application_guide.html</u> from September 2013).

A shortlist of candidates for the scholarship will be drawn up during March/April 2014 and interviews, if needed, will be organised by the Oxford Australia Fund Scholarships Committee, to be held in Australia in April/May.
