James Fairfax - Oxford Australia Clarendon Fund Scholarship

1. The Awards

A Scholarship, funded through the generosity of Australians who have studied at Oxford, and in particular the late Mr James Fairfax AC, and in partnership with the Oxford Clarendon Fund, is available in 2019-2020 for a graduate from Australia to study for **one** postgraduate or **one** Second BA degree at Oxford University.

The James Fairfax - Oxford Australia Clarendon Fund Scholarship is open to any discipline and is generally tenable for two years, or, in the case of a D Phil degree, for three years. The scholarship is also intended for those wishing to study for a second undergraduate degree or a graduate degree in the Arts or Social Sciences. **Normally, the scholarship is intended for undergraduate and graduate students, currently studying or working in Australia, to pursue their first international degree.**

2. Eligibility

In addition to the usual Clarendon selection criteria, the James Fairfax Oxford Australia Clarendon partnership awardee will normally be selected on the following additional criteria:

- be an Australian citizen normally resident in Australia
- hold a Bachelor's degree with first class Honours, or its equivalent, from a recognized Australian university
- not have studied overseas for an international degree.

Normally, the scholarship is intended for undergraduate and graduate students, currently studying or working in Australia, to pursue their first international degree. It is the responsibility of each applicant to ensure that their qualifications meet the requirements of their chosen Oxford University course.

3. Value of the Awards

The James Fairfax Oxford Australia Clarendon Scholarship covers all university and College fees and provides a generous living allowance for the duration of the course.

4. Application Procedure

All graduate applications to Oxford University are automatically considered for a Clarendon Award (www.clarendon.ox.ac.uk) and Oxford University Graduate Admissions will select the awardee for the James Fairfax Oxford Australia Clarendon Scholarship, based on the above criteria.

5. Closing dates and timelines
